Early Career Researcher Travel Support

Travel support is available for up to 10 Early Career Researchers to attend the Respect 4 Neurodevelopment Annual Event in London. Maximum of £250 per person.

PhD students, Research Assistants, and Postdoctoral Researchers (who do not have their own conference funding) are encouraged to apply.

To be eligible for this, you must have submitted an abstract for a poster presentation.

Travel support will be awarded based on abstract quality, as well as personal circumstances. Priority will be given to Early Career Researchers, Neurodivergent Researchers, but other circumstances will also be considered to enable those attending in person who would otherwise find this difficult.

Neurodivergent Travel Support

Travel support is available for up to 10 people that are neurodivergent / have lived experience of neurodevelopmental conditions to attend the Respect 4 Neurodevelopment Annual Event in London. Maximum of £250 per person.

Priority will be given to those who would otherwise find it difficult to attend.
